

Have your say on Swain's Lane Safe and Healthy Streets Scheme





The Covid-19 pandemic has changed how communities in Camden live, travel and work. We want our streets to have **more space** for everyone to walk and cycle, for you to be **breathing cleaner air**, for children to get to and from school **safely** and for businesses to **flourish**.



The changes to Swain's Lane

We've been trialling changes on Swain's Lane to help make streets safer and healthier by deterring vehicles trying to use Swain's Lane as a cut-through between Parliament Hill and Highgate Village. The changes aim to reduce traffic levels on Swain's Lane to make it safer for people to walk and cycle locally and to improve air quality.

We are now consulting on making the following changes permanent:

- Banning vehicles on Swain's Lane from turning right into Bisham Gardens
- Banning vehicles on Swain's Lane from turning right into South Grove

We know that traffic levels across Swain's Lane, South Grove and Chester Road have reduced since we made these trial changes and that more people have been cycling through the area. However, we have also had feedback that, as a result of the scheme on Swain's Lane, traffic levels have increased on other streets in the area. We've been listening to residents and stakeholders during the trial and all comments received so far will be taken into account as part of this consultation. We now want to know how you feel about keeping these changes permanently, or modifying them, and also your suggestions for other traffic interventions in the area.

Traffic issues in the area are also being investigated as part of a new scheme for the wider Dartmouth Park area, and will be subject to a separate consultation process in due course.
